Erin Ruoff Jennifer Welte The October 27, 2015 meeting of the Land Committee was called to order by Ray Lambert, Chairman of the Board of Natural Resources.

Chairman Lambert called on Dwight Davis, Chairman of the Land Committee, who called on Steve Friedman, Chief of Real Estate.

Mr. Friedman stated the item for consideration would be the approval to enter into a five (5) year Lease Agreement with the United States Postal Services on Sapelo Island.

Mr. Friedman stated in 1981, the USPS leased 231 sq. ft. of building space from the Department to provide a mail delivery service to residents of Sapelo Island. He further stated the current agreement expires on June 30, 2017, and the USPS historically renews lease agreements two years in advance of the expiration date. He added since the Department is responsible for upkeep and maintenance of the building, an annual rent of \$1,756 will be paid to the Department.

Mr. Friedman stated he would request the Committee recommend that the Board approve the item as presented.

A motion was made by Mr. Leebern, seconded by Mr. Shailendra and carried unanimously that the Committee recommend that the Board adopt the Resolution to authorize the Commissioner to seek State Properties Commission approval to enter into a five (5) year Lease Agreement with the United States Postal Service, Sapelo Island, McIntosh County, as presented.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
