The December 13, 2016 meeting of the Wildlife Resources Committee was called to order by Chairman William Bagwell.

Chairman Bagwell called on Aaron McWhorter, Chairman of the Wildlife Resources Committee.

Mr. McWhorter called on John Bowers, Chief of Game Management of the Wildlife Resources Division, to present the proposed amendments to Hunting Regulations for Wildlife Management Areas (WMAs) and Other State Lands, Chapter 391-4-2-.70.

Mr. Bowers stated that he has one action item to bring before the Board today, concerning the Alapaha Creek WMA. He further stated that this is a newly acquired property consisting of 3,088 acres located in Wheeler County. He added that these regulations would add turkey hunting dates for 2017.

Mr. Bowers stated that he would return to the Board at the February meeting for consideration after a public comment period and public hearing was held.
