Chairman McWhorter called on Dwight Davis, Chairman of the Land Committee, who called on Steve Friedman, Chief of Real Estate.

Mr. Friedman stated that Item A is a request to enter into a short-term agreement with Hall County or the City of Gainesville for the Lake Lanier Parcel, 1.32± acres, Hall County. He further stated that this property is connected to the Lake Lanier Olympic Park and would be incorporated into the park's recreation purposes.

Mr. Friedman stated that he would request the Committee recommend that the Board approve the item as presented.

<u>A motion was made by Mr. Bagwell, seconded by Mr. New, and carried unanimously</u> that the Committee recommend that the Board adopt the Resolution to authorize the <u>Commissioner to seek State Properties Commission approval to enter into a short-term</u> <u>agreement with Hall County or the City of Gainesville for the Lake Lanier Parcel, 1.32± acres,</u> <u>Hall County, as presented.</u>

Mr. Friedman stated that Item B is a request to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with Jenkins County to install a safety fence at Magnolia Springs State Park, Jenkins County. He further stated that this fence will keep animals and visitors from accessing the airport that sits next to the park.

Mr. Friedman stated that he would request the Committee recommend that the Board approve the item as presented.

<u>A motion was made by Mr. Phelps, seconded by Mr. Shailendra, and carried</u> <u>unanimously that the Committee recommend that the Board adopt the Resolution to authorize</u> <u>the Commissioner to seek State Properties Commission approval to enter into an</u> <u>Intergovernmental Agreement with Jenkins County to install a safety fence at Magnolia Springs</u> <u>State Park, Jenkins County, as presented.</u>

Mr. Friedman stated that Item C is a granting of a revocable license agreement of 1.743± acres to Evans County by the State Properties Commission to improve Sand Pond Road at Evans County PFA. He further stated that Sand Pond Road is the main access to the public campground.

Mr. Friedman stated that he would request the Committee recommend that the Board approve the item as presented.

<u>A motion was made by Mr. Jones, seconded by Mr. New, and carried unanimously that</u> the Committee recommend that the Board adopt the Resolution to authorize the Commissioner Minutes – Land Committee January 16, 2019 Page 3

to seek State Properties Commission approval to grant a revocable license agreement of 1.743± acres to Evans County by the State Properties Commission to improve Sand Pond Road at Evans County Public Fishing Area, as presented.
