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The June 25, 2019 meeting of the Land Committee was called to order by Bodine Sinyard, Chairman of the Board of Natural Resources.

Chairman Sinyard called on Dwight Davis, Chairman of the Land Committee, who called on Steve Friedman, Chief of Real Estate.

Mr. Friedman stated that Item A is the request for approval to enter into a 25-year lease with Georgia Power Company over the 27.8 acres Dames Ferry Campground, Monroe County. He further stated that Parks is currently managing the campground under a 1-year MOU with Georgia Power. He added that it will be operated as a satellite to High Falls State Park and is expected to increase the revenues for that park. He stated that this is a no cost lease to the department.

Mr. Friedman stated that he would request the Committee recommend that the Board approve the item as presented.

A motion was made by Mr. Davis, seconded by Mr. Evans, and carried unanimously that the Committee recommend that the Board adopt the Resolution to authorize the Commissioner to seek State Properties Commission approval to enter into a 25-year lease with Georgia Power Company over the 27.8 acres Dames Ferry Campground, Monroe County, as presented.
