The February 28, 2017 meeting of the Wildlife Resources Committee was called to order by Chairman Duncan Johnson, Jr.

Chairman Johnson called on Dwight Evans, Vice Chairman of the Wildlife Resources Committee.

Mr. Evans called on John Bowers, Chief of Game Management of the Wildlife Resources Division, to present the proposed amendments to Hunting Regulations for Wildlife Management Areas (WMAs) and Other State Lands, Chapter 391-4-2-.70.

Mr. Bowers stated that he has one action item to bring before the Board today, concerning the Alligator Creek Wildlife Management Area. He further stated that this was a recent acquisition and the proposed regulations establish turkey hunting opportunity for the current season. He added that there will be more comprehensive hunting opportunity for this property that will be brought to you next month and included in the hunting regulations two-year cycle.

Mr. Bowers requested favorable consideration of the proposed regulations.

A motion was made by Mr. Watt, seconded by Mr. Mobley, and carried unanimously that the Committee recommend that the Board adopt the Resolution to approve the proposed amendments to Hunting Regulations for WMAs and Other State Lands, Chapter 391-4-2-.70, as presented.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
